10-Night Itinerary

Sun, September 22 DEPART THE UNITED STATES

Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic. Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service as you travel to start your vacation.

Mon, September 23 ROME ARRIVAL

After landing at Rome Airport, complete customs and immigration formalities. Your tour director will welcome you to Italy and escort you and your luggage to the coach. Transfer to your hotel, check in and enjoy some free time to settle into your room. In the afternoon, set off on an orientation walking tour to see some of the city's most popular sights. Along the way, visit the famous Spanish Steps, a set of steps dating from 1723 and considered to be the widest and longest staircase in Europe. Then, continue on to view the awe-inspiring Trevi Fountain. Tradition maintains, that if you throw a throw a coin into the Trevi Fountain, it means that someday you will return to Rome. Head back to your hotel, where you might like to freshen up before joining your group for a welcome dinner at a local venue.

ROME SIGHTSEEING

Tue, September 24

This morning, celebrate Mass with your group before setting off to see more highlights of the Eternal City of Rome. Stop to visit the Roman Forum, which is often considered the center of Ancient Roman life. It was here, that religion, commerce, judicial cases and politics would often unfold. Next, visit the Colosseum, where fit gladiators often fought in action packed shows and early Christians were sometimes martyred. The Colosseum had the ability to hold up to 50,000 spectators and is one of the great architectural achievements of Ancient Rome. Then, continue on to view the Pantheon, which is one of the best-preserved monuments of antiquity and was built by Augustus' son-in-law, Agrippa. The Pantheon contains not only works of art by the likes of Raphael but also the tombs of the kings of Italy. After, have a look around Piazza Navona, favored for its beauty and for its architecturally stunning fountains. Return to your hotel and spend the remainder of the day free to sightsee, shop and dine on your own.

Wed, September 25 VATICAN MUSEUM & SISTINE CHAPEL

Today, visit the Papal Audience to witness an unforgettable day with the Pope. His Holiness will address the audience in several languages and will conclude with an apostolic blessing. Then, continue on to tour the Vatican Museum and Sistine Chapel, where out of respect for its sacredness, the Vatican has requested silence during your visit. While here, you will see magnificent sculptures, Maps Gallery and the Hall of Tapestries. The tour ends in the Sistine Chapel, where you can view Michelangelo's Creation and the famous Last Judgment. Next, visit the massive St. Peter's Basilica, which is the largest church in Christendom and can hold up to 60,000 people. Tradition maintains that Saint Peter's tomb is below the altar. Return to your hotel and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure for individual pursuits and dining.

Thu, September 26 ROME TO FLORENCE

Leaving Rome, travel into Siena and stop to celebrate mass with your fellow travelers. After, head to a local venue to enjoy a traditional Tuscan lunch followed by a wine tasting. This evening, join your group for dinner in the hotel restaurant.

Fri, September 27 ACCADEMIA MUSEUM

After breakfast, set off on a guided walking tour of Florence, a city of artistic wealth and beauty. Stop to visit the Accademia Museum, which was founded in 1784 and hosts a collection of sculptures, picture galleries and paintings. One of the most important works on display at the museum is David by Michelangelo completed around 1504. Then, head to the beautiful Piazza Del Duomo for photos of the Cathedral of Santa Maria Del Fiore. After, celebrate Mass with your group before returning to your hotel. Tonight, you might like to sample the local cuisine by dining at a nearby venue.

Sat, September 28 LUCCA SIGHTSEEING

This morning, drive into Lucca, birthplace of Italian composer, Giacomo Puccini. Sun, September 29 FLORENCE TO ASSISI

Departing Florence, travel southeast through the town of Perugia before reaching the town of Assisi, which is known as the birthplace of Saint Francis. Upon arrival, stop to celebrate mass with your fellow travelers. Then, visit the Basilica of San Francis, which was built between 1228 and 1253 AD. The short construction period was rare for a church of this size but is often explained by the great love that the people of the time had for St. Francis. Transfer to your nearby hotel, check in and enjoy the balance of the afternoon at leisure. In the evening, meet your group in the hotel restaurant for a delicious meal.
